

Topic: IMEKO2020 Full papers can be published in Acta IMEKO TC3, TC5, TC16 and TC22 Special Issue

Dear Colleague,

We hope that you are well, and we thank you for submitting Full Paper to IMEKO TC3, TC5, TC16 and TC22 International Conference. Due to the situation with the corona virus, the conference was postponed to 11 - 13 October 2022 and the new website will be prepared at the beginning of next year.

The already submitted papers have undergone full peer review and the authors have the possibility to:

- publish their papers in the Acta IMEKO journal to be issued soon (December 2020 or January 2021) or
- to withdraw them from IMEKO2020.

If you want to have your paper **published in the Special issue of Acta IMEKO**, we need your consent. So please:

- 1) Send an e-mail to imeko2020@fsb.hr with the sentence:
I want my paper entitled "...", submitted to TC.., to be published in the Special issue of the journal Acta IMEKO. Please send this e-mail before midnight 29 November 2020. **There will be no fee for publication in the Special issue of Acta IMEKO.**
- 2) Please make sure that you have uploaded the final version of your Full Paper in **MS Word format** after completion of the refereeing process. If you have uploaded the final and corrected version there is nothing more for you to do. If you have not uploaded the final version, please upload the final refereed and corrected version to the IMEKO2020 conference system (NOT to Acta IMEKO!). To upload the final and corrected version:
 - a. Log in to the IMEKO2020 conference web site: https://conferences.imeko.org/index.php/tc3-5-16-22_2020/2020.
 - b. After successful log-in you should see the page "UserHome" with the conference and a link called "» Author". Click this link.
 - c. You should now see the page "Active Submissions". Click on the title of the submission you want to update.
 - d. You should see the number of your submission and the Summary. Underneath the page title there are two links: SUMMARY and REVIEW.
 - e. Please check if the "Submission Metadata" is still correct. If there were changes in the authors or the title or the abstract of the paper, please click on "Edit Metadata" and correct the data. At the end, use the "Save Metadata" button to apply the changes.
 - f. Now click on REVIEW. In the section "Director Decision" you can find "Upload Author Version" where you can select the final version of your Full Paper from your local device and upload this file. Please select at first the file and press then the "Upload" button to upload the file to the server.
 - g. Please use the small letter image close to "Notify director" to send an e-mail to the track director. Type a note in the Body textbox and use the "Send" button to send the e-mail.
 - h. If something goes wrong with the submission of the final version of your Full Paper, please contact your Track director (the chair of the corresponding TC) or the organizers (e-mail address is given above).

If you want to **withdraw your paper** please send an e-mail to imeko2020@fsb.hr with the sentence:

I want to withdraw my paper titled "....", submitted to TC... .

Nothing more needs to be done - we will only make a remark in the system.

We are looking forward to meeting you at IMEKO TC3, TC5, TC16 and TC22 International Conference 2022 in Dubrovnik.
