The 138 oral and 107 poster presentations of the conference resulted in a total of 235 manuscripts for consideration in the printed proceedings (some presentations were intended as 'oral only').

Four TEMPMEKO 2007 Proceedings issues have been published as special issues of the International Journal of Thermophysics:

Vol. 28, No. 6 (December), 2007, TEMPMEKO Proceedings Issue 1, 43 papers

Vol. 29, No. 1 (February), 2008, TEMPMEKO Proceedings Issue 2, 41 papers

Vol. 29, No. 3 (June), 2008, TEMPMEKO Proceedings Issue 3, 39 papers

Vol. 29, No. 5 (October), 2008, TEMPMEKO Proceedings Issue 4, 37 papers

The final Proceedings issue, the February 2009 issue of IJT, is nearly complete. Only one paper remains, and its fate will soon be decided – I am waiting for a revised manuscript from the authors. At the time of writing, 27 TEMPMEKO papers of an anticipated total of 35 from the final issue are available in the Online First area of the web site, for a total of 187 published to date. The accessible content may depend on the kind of subscription that your institution has with Springer and IJT.

A total of 194 papers have been 'Accepted' for publication, 22 have been 'Rejected' (of these, 1 was published elsewhere and 1 was not presented at TEMPMEKO), and 18 were 'Withdrawn' by the authors at some point during the review cycle.

There was sufficient interest in printed copies of the proceedings to order 70 copies of each issue. I will distribute them to those who expressed interest as soon as I have all of the copies in hand.

I would like to conclude what I expect to be my last report by thanking the Associate Editors (Stephanie Bell, Jürgen Hartmann, Greg Strouse, and Rod White), the IJT Editor (Mickey Haynes), Francesco Righini, and all the authors and reviewers. Editing the proceedings was challenging, but a very rewarding experience. I wish the organizers of TEMPMEKO 2010 great success, and I hope to see many of you in Slovenia.
