The main feature of this Newsletter is a report by the Editor of the Proceedings of TEMPMEKO 2007 that provides details on the matter up to early June. The publication is almost complete and, one year after the event, 141 papers have already been published. This is a significant achievement and we should thank both the Proceedings Editor and the journal Editor for an excellent job. I heard praise from several colleagues, in particular young authors, that were very happy to be able to publish in an international journal with a significant impact factor in a very reasonable time frame.

The section on TC12 News provides details about new members and information on the new TC12 website.

Some proposals regarding rules and regulations for "joint events" of IMEKO TCs with other institutions have been submitted to IMEKO and will be discussed during the September meetings.

The 138 oral and 107 poster presentations of the conference resulted in a total of 235 manuscripts for consideration in the printed proceedings.

Publication of the submitted papers is nearing completion. I have 'Accepted' for publication 178 papers, 23 have been 'Rejected' (of these, 1 was published elsewhere and 1 was not presented at TEMPMEKO), 9 were 'Withdrawn' by the authors at some point in the review cycle, 9 are 'Under Review' (the author has revised the manuscript to address the reviewer's comments), 13 are 'Waiting for Authors' to respond to the reviews, and the 'Reviewer is Unassigned' for 3 NRC-authored manuscripts.

I am very satisfied that nearly 90% of the TEMPMEKO papers have been processed, but disappointed that the task could not be completed

by the one-year anniversary of the conference. I encourage authors with reviews in hand to revise their papers as soon as possible as I will need to impose a deadline at some point so that the proceedings may be closed and the final issue prepared.

Regarding the situation at the journal side, three Special Issues of the International Journal of Thermophysics containing the TEMPMEKO Proceedings have been assembled:

Vol. 28, No. 6, 2007, TEMPMEKO Proceedings Issue 1, 43 papers

Vol. 29, No. 1, 2008, TEMPMEKO Proceedings Issue 2, 41 papers

Vol. 29, No. 3, 2008, TEMPMEKO Proceedings Issue 3, 39 papers

In addition, 18 TEMPMEKO papers are available in the Online First area of the web site,

for a total of 141 published to date. The accessible content may depend on the kind of subscription that your institution has with Springer and IJT.

There was sufficient interest in printed copies of the proceedings for me to order 70 copies of each issue. I am currently holding the issues and will distribute them to those who expressed interest, as soon as all of the issues are printed.

I would like to conclude this interim report by thanking the Associate Editors, the IJT Editor,

all the authors and reviewers for their work in producing the Proceedings of TEMPMEKO 2007. It is my sincere hope that, with their continued cooperation, all of the papers to appear in the Proceedings will be processed and sent to the IJT Editor by September.
