1 Opening address

Prof. Bernhard Zagar formally opens the TC2 meeting and welcomes all participants. He announces that the meeting has been invited for properly by email sent out on July 3rd 2012

2 Approval of Minutes (Linz, May 18th 2011)

There are no remarks or comments concerning the minutes of the last meeting in Linz, so they are approved.

3 Report of the Chairman

- Prof. Zagar reports of the activities of the IMEKO TC2 group in the last year. In particular there were 16 TC2 abstracts submitted for the World Congress in Busan and the review process yielded that 11 oral presentations and 2 poster presentations were finally accepted.
- There is a new guideline planned for future TC conferences, symposia and workshops that will formally be announced shortly and which IMEKO likes its organizers to adhere to.
- Prof. Simone Carmignato from the University of Padova, Italy regrets that he is not able to attend but has two suggestions the members might discuss and decide upon.
 - a) In particular he suggests that one of the future TC2 events be held in Padova, Italy organized by himself. Quote: "As already discussed last year with Prof. Tilo Pfeifer, I confirm that we at University of Padova would be happy to host a future meeting of IMEKO TC2, including a small conference or symposium." end quote.
 - b) He further suggests that quote: "I would like to suggest that X-ray measurement techniques (such as Computed Tomography) could be explicitly added to the fields of interest of IMEKO TC2. In my opinion, measurements using X-ray photons fit perfectly within the TC2 aims and would also contribute substantially to the development of TC2. Metrology using Computed Tomography, in particular, has been recently attracting more and more interest by industries and research institutes." end quote.

After a short discussion it was agreed upon that both applications and suggestions are accepted as such.
